**2. Minutes of last Meeting and matters arising**

The minutes of the meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2019 were accepted and signed.

The quiz night went very well and a profit of £557 was made. We also did well at the Xmas light evening, and we had a tree in the Christmas tree festival at the church. Liability insurance has been done and we have received £500 from Louisa Sullivan for communication.

There is a Heathrow meeting on 20<sup>th</sup> January and CB and PL will attend.

**3. Chairperson's report**

We have agreed all dates for meetings in 2020 and they will be at 7.00pm in Colstan Hall.

SL will send out again with revised dates for the larger general meetings. We are beginning to be known and invited to attend local groups and forums such as Heathrow and M4 groups etc. and we will attend as many as possible. Some funding will have to be "matched funding". We need to keep on pressing to get things done.

Survey will go to residents asking them what they would like to see done and what they would like us to spend any grants on.

We will ask Iver Heath Residents Association and Richings Park if they could attend any of our meetings to advise on how we go about approaching sources of funding.

JL is meeting Iver Heath to discuss pollution this week.

We will develop a strategy on parking and get other members of the public involved. Also to involve Jane Brown, (Neighbourhood watch). Sam has met with Jane Brown and is going to set up a neighbourhood watch scheme in Leas Drive.

In May we will have the election for a new parish council and things could change over what powers they have and there will also be the new unified council

CB will ask members if anyone is interested in standing as a parish councilor and will check on the rules.

CA will attend the beginning of the next parish council meeting.

CB has written to the two other residents' associations and to councilors asking for a joint meeting to discuss traffic and pollution. We could adopt a system where HGVs are routed on a one-way system through Iver Village and Richings Park as it the traffic jams that cause the pollution and increasing the flow would improve the situation.

CB to circulate a list of meetings and forums coming up to see who can attend them and report back.

**4. Treasurer's report**

Balance in bank is £1360.52. The liability insurance has been paid, but we need a safeguarding protocol which CA and PL will do, and an accident book.

**5. Membership Secretary's report.**

Still to recheck database as some residents are not receiving emails.

**6. Sub Committees.**

Parking group are going to have a meeting to set up a short-term goal and develop a strategy, maybe liaising with the parish council. CB has had no response from the person who can help with a parking scheme.

There is an excellent report on pollution by Kings College. FG to pass on details.

**7. AOB.** To discuss website at next meeting. To advertise the association more widely and try to put an article in the two local magazines, depending on the cost.

It was agreed that producing a newsletter is important to keep members informed.
