Ciaran Beary spoke about the preliminary steps that lead to proposing an Iver Village Residents Association (IVRA). Both Richings Park and Iver Heath have active residents associations.

Iver area faces many challenges. Some issues that might concern residents include:

- High Street pollution affecting children and adults; lorry traffic, re-filling Colne Valley park.
- Improved opportunities and activities for youth and children; Fundraising.
- Parking improvements and control on High street.
- Housing proposals: i.e.: proposal for 1,500 new houses in Richings park area; 7,000 proposed for the whole of Bucks, Iver getting too many!

Providing a voice on various forums and committees. e.g.; Heathrow etc.
