Minutes for the committee meeting held on 10th February 2020 at Iver Village Hall at 7.00 pm.

1. Apologies for Absence: SF, PL, TW and LP

2. Minutes of last Meeting and matters arising

The minutes of the meeting on 13th January 2020 were accepted and signed.

CB has spoken to Iver Heath and Richings Park residents' associations about joining our meetings and we will be invited to attend theirs.

CB is to stand for the parish council and will inform all our members how they could be a councilor and what is involved.

The front page of the website has been completed but we still need to get it up and running. If approved we will allocate some of the £500 that we were given for communication to have a website set up in a similar style to that of Iver Heath.

SF is prepared to write up the latest news from the group- we need a monthly update and an editorial date. JL, CB and SF to meet to get the first newsletter sent out. PL still to check on those that have not received emails. We can ask on the website for everyone to check that we have the correct email.

To organize a communication strategy group to discuss what to do and what we are able to achieve, and explore ways of communication, getting younger residents involved and possibility of setting up conference facilities online for our meetings.

We need to consider, after the survey has been completed, who we need to make contact with.

3 Chairperson's report

CB and JL attended the Neighbourhood Community Forum, organized by the police in South Bucks, at Richings Park. They appear to have very limited resources and CB challenged them on parking. They are prepared to come to a meeting.

CB attended a meeting of the Heathrow liaison group and spoke to Stephen Beauchamp. Regardless of the plans for a third runway we still have a lot of issues in Iver due to problems caused by traffic from the airport, especially illegal parking. We have 7 illegal car parks in the area. He will come to have a look at these and take some photos. CB to walk him around the village to show him what we would like to do to help the parking problem and see if we can get any funds towards this.

To get tough with Bucks County Council and complain to the ombudsman that they are not doing anything to alleviate parking and pollution issues.

CB and CA will attend the parish council meeting this week.

To explore the possibility of CCTV cameras and how much they would cost. CB will speak to Graham from Richings Park as they have already set these up.

Suggest to DEFRA that they look at pollution in Iver village separately, as was the original plan. There is a massive increase in cases of asthma in the Ivers. We could ask the council to consider their contract with school buses that have very bad emissions.

4. Treasurer's report

CA and SL need to ring bank together to sort out access for SL.

5. Membership Secretary's report.

Some residents are not receiving emails.
